

# Leisuretime Pool Cover Warranty

## warranty and cover care instructions

### **LEISURETIME POOL COVER LIMITED WARRANTY**

Your Pool Cover is guaranteed for 36 months by the manufacturer to be free from material delamination and manufacturing faults when installed in accordance with the Manufacturers Installation and Maintenance Instructions. This warranty does not apply to damage to the Cover resulting from accident, misuse or abuse of the product (including punctures, rips and tears), alteration or modification of the product after your purchase, or chemical damage or delamination caused by sun exposure or excessive heat while the cover is off the pool or excessive chlorine exposure.

Please Note: replacement of cover under warranty does not extend warranty period.

**MAINTENANCE AND CARE:** It is important that you follow these instructions in order to ensure that your warranty remains valid.

- Care in Handling – To prevent damage to the Pool Cover, the Pool Cover should be carefully lifted over abrasive pool decks, coping or any sharp ragged surface.
- Cleaning – Use warm soapy water to clean your Pool Cover. To keep your pool cleaner, promptly dispose of dirt and debris by hosing off the dirt and leaves from the floating Pool Cover.
- Before you super chlorinate your pool, the Pool Cover must be removed and kept off till the level of chlorine is below 3 parts per million (PPM). The Chlorine level should be monitored to make sure it does not rise above the recommended level.
- During periods of extremely high winds it is recommended that you remove the Pool Cover from the Pool.
- Extend the life of the Pool Cover by using a Leisuretime Roller System
